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2) Topic: Understanding and Optimizing Plasma for Gas Conversion by Optical

Diagnostics

Belgium)

Chatterjee started his presentation with the definition and explanation of plasma. Matter changes its state when energy is supplied to it, solid become liquid and liquids become gaseous. If even more energy is supplied to a gas, it is ionized and goes into the energy rich plasma state, the fourth state of matter. He also discussed about medical application of plasma technology. The ability to produce cold plasma at atmospheric pressure conditions was the basis for rapid growth of plasma related application areas in biomedicine. For medical applications two different types of cold plasma appear suitable: indirect (plasma jet) and direct (dielectric barrier discharge-DBD) plasma sources.

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4) Topic: The other Ray: The Aesthetics of His Book Designs



A special talk on "The Other Ray: Aesthetics of his Book Designs" had renowned Illustrator and Graphic Designer, Pinaki De, also Associate Professor in the Dept. of English Peary Mohan College, Uttarpara, West Bengal focus our attention to the Alternative Satyajit Ray whose filmmaking fame may have eclipsed his multi-talent towards book cover designs and advertisement creations. Having learnt on different schools of thought regarding art from Visva-Bharati and Benode Bihari Mukherjee as a conspicuous influence, Ray would go on to carve a niche in the world of advertisement that would showcase his idiosyncratic style. Ray worked at the very institutional D.J.Keymer ad-agency and later went on to create advertisements of his own films and designed book covers of his own and others. The audience was shown several of his book cover designs, advertisement templates and the iconic Nandan logo designed by Ray.







5) Topic: Chemistry of semiconductor Nanocrystals: laboratory to Display industries(tv and leds)

In recent years, colloidal cesium lead halide (CsPbX3) perovskite nanocrystals (PNCs) have attracted significant attention from researchers due to their unique optical properties and potential use in optoelectronic applications. In colloidal synthesis, oleic acid and oleylamine are commonly used as surface-capping ligands. Although oleylamine plays a crucial role in maintaining the colloidal stability and surface passivation of PNCs, its dynamic equilibrium with oleic acid leads to the formation of labile oleylammonium, which pulls halides from the surface of PNCs and thus degrades the crystals. In this Perspective, we summarize the various approaches for eliminating the amines to make high-quality, photostable, and amine-free CsPbX3 PNCs. In addition, we look over the prospects of these PNCs regarding stability in different environmental conditions, photoluminescence properties, and optoelectronic device performance. This perspective will give a broad overview of amine-free PNCs starting from their synthesis, challenges, and optoelectronic properties to their future prospects.
